Dress Code for the activities you are enjoying.



Dress Code

Country Club Casual

Collared shirts for men and appropriate dress for women is required. Nice jeans are acceptable (not ripped, torn, tattered, frayed or dirty). Proper Golf and Tennis attire is acceptable.

Not Acceptable

Cotton t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, tank tops, tube tops, midriff baring attire, short shorts, cut-offs and inappropriate athletic attire including yoga pants, short athletic shorts, bike shorts, and warm-up suits unless inside the Fitness Rooms, Tennis Courts or Pool areas. For sports attire that violates the Club dress code, appropriate outerwear is required as a cover up.

Hats

Should be worn with the bill facing forward (not backwards) on the Golf Course, at the Grille and on the Patios. Hats are not acceptable inside the Clubhouse for gentlemen. Dressy Hats, religious or health related head coverings will be allowed for appropriate occasions.

Shoes

Golf shoes, dress and casual shoes such as loafers and sandals are suggested footwear on Club grounds.

Children's Dress Policy

For children under 12, we ask parents to encourage appropriate dress while at the Club. Once children turn 12 years old, they are expected to comply with the adult dress code policies.

GOLF - To include Golf Course, Practice Facility, and Putting Green

Men's Dress Policy

Collared shirts only. Recommended tucked in. Long sleeve mock neck in winter. Slacks and Bermuda golf shorts.

Hats with the bill forward.

No - Jeans, cargo shorts/pants, athletic shorts, bike shorts, t-shirts, and warm-up suits

Ladies' Dress Policy

Slacks, golf shorts, capris, skirts or skorts longer than fingertips.

Golf shirts, sleeveless blouses with collar or mock neck shirts are appropriate.

No - Tube tops, tank tops, midriff baring attire, denim blouses, t-shirts, short shorts, cut-offs, jeans, cargo shorts/pants, athletic shorts, bike shorts, yoga attire and warm-up suits

Children

We love that Eagle Brook's littlest members get to enjoy the club. Please keep in mind all children 16 and under must be supervised by an adult, and must be 18 to enter the locker room unaccompanied.

As a reminder, please make sure all Members and their guests are in accordance with the EBCC Dress Code policy while using any golf facility including the range. These include but are not limited to:

“Men's shirts must have collars. Shorts must be of Bermuda length or a style specifically designed for golf. Golf shoes which follow the Club's posted spikeless policy must be worn on the course. All the following types of clothing are prohibited on the golf course: denim pants of all types and designs; short shorts, cutoffs, running shorts; tennis-length skirts; t-shirts, tank tops and sweatshirts. Only soft spike golf shoes or other approved shoes shall be worn on the golf course and practice areas. Any shoes other than golf shoes must be approved by the Golf Shop.”

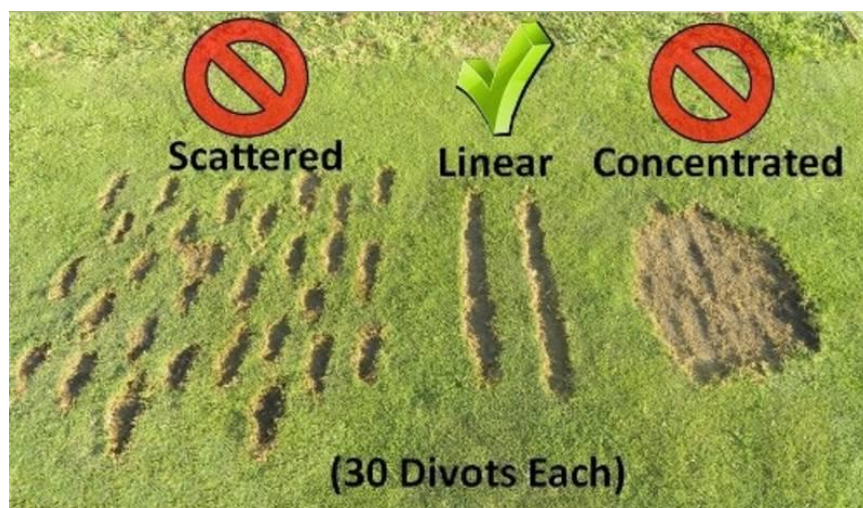
As Summer heat enters the area, our maintenance team may need to work on the course on certain days providing some light watering to all turf. Please allow some extra time if approaching a hole that may have sprinklers running or if a team member is hand watering.

Our goal is for each of you to enjoy your round in a timely fashion, but also to provide some cool down relief for our turf on certain days.

We appreciate your understanding and patience during these particularly warm days. We look forward to seeing all of you out on our beautiful course enjoying summer!

Driving Range Etiquette

In order to maximize turf space and increase turf recovery time, please make sure that we use the range in the following manner:



JULY GOLF

Course Care

Please utilize the following practices to make sure the course stays in the best shape possible the entire season:

- 1) Repair your ball marks on putting surfaces (see diagram below).
- 2) Please repair all divots in fairways using the provided sand and seed bottles.
- 3) Please keep all carts out of all native and fescue areas.
- 4) Please return to the cart path when you approach our greens, as indicated by the white posts with the blue tops.

How To Repair a Ball Mark

A few extra seconds is all it takes to keep the putting greens looking and playing their best.





CHOOSE WISELY

A ball mark repair tool is recommended, but other pointed devices can be used.



PUSH DON'T PRY

Starting from the back and sides, gently push & stretch the turf to the center of the mark.



WORK AROUND

Work around the ball mark until it's filled in. Avoid lifting & twisting the turf harshly.



FINAL TOUCH

Use your putter to lightly tap down the mark. Fix other marks in addition to yours.
