MESSAGE FROM OUR SUPERINTENDENT July, 2023

As we head into the heart of summer here in the Fox Valley, the Eagle Brook Agronomy Team wanted to update Membership regarding course conditions. Beginning with the mild and largely snowless winter, segueing into a historic lack of rainfall in the region this spring and early summer, it has been an uphill battle to maintain a proper water supply. As has been the case all season you will continue to witness around the clock attention to the course in order to protect and maintain the infrastructure of our water source during this 20-year drought. Late last fall, our Club accomplished a complex and comprehensive bunker renovation project in record time, courtesy of an incredible team of hard-working individuals in conjunction with Mother Nature's cooperation. A total of two days were lost to weather, allowing the entire project to be completed in the fall, several months ahead of schedule. Sometimes these extreme conditions are a blessing - other times, not so much.

When Eagle Brook was built in late 1992, it was designed to collect 85% of all storm water run-off from various locations throughout Geneva and surrounding areas. This water enters the creek running in front of hole #6 to provide the primary source for our irrigation system. As a secondary supply resource, we have 2 wells that produce a combined 650 gallons of water per minute to replenish our creek nightly. In the absence of rainfall / storm water run-off to replenish our system, our well pumps are simply unable to keep up with the current water demands associated with low dew points and temperatures in the mid 80s. For example, a normal irrigation cycle would require 500,000 gallons of water to be pulled from the creek; running the well pumps at full capacity overnight only yields 312,000 gallons of replacement water. In order to offset this discrepancy, our Team must incorporate more selective hand watering practices while monitoring levels and maintaining a delicate balance as we await the next rainfall.

Our focus, from a Club perspective, is to ensure proper playing conditions first and foremost on putting green surfaces followed by tee and fairway surfaces. Due to lack of irrigated rough when the course was built, we will water this portion of the course as needed. This may prolong a lot of our germination in the hydro seeded areas and will be addressed with proper seeding methods once water sources and temperatures level out. The positive is that the grass plant is very healthy and responds when proper growing conditions are present. We will persevere in our mission to provide the best course conditions possible.

We greatly appreciate the support, patience and understanding of each and every one of you during these difficult and stressful times. Our Team takes a proactive approach in order to anticipate how best to handle issues as they arise; Eagle Brook's challenges are unique in nature. To end on a high note, our turf is extremely healthy and we will see many positive developments as conditions return to normal in the coming months.



Only soft spike golf shoes or other approved shoes shall be worn on the golf course and practice areas. Any shoes other than golf shoes must be approved by the Golf Shop."





Adults

GOLF - To include Golf Course, Practice Facility, and Putting Green <u>Men's Dress Policy</u>

Collared shirts only. Recommended tucked in. Long sleeve mock neck in winter. Slacks and Bermuda golf shorts.

Hats with the bill forward.

No - Jeans, cargo shorts/pants, athletic shorts, bike shorts, t-shirts, and warm-up suits <u>Ladies' Dress Policy</u>

Slacks, golf shorts, capris, skirts or skorts longer than fingertips.

Golf shirts, sleeveless blouses with collar or mock neck shirts are appropriate.

No - Tube tops, tank tops, midriff baring attire, denim blouses, t-shirts, short shorts, cut-offs, jeans, cargo shorts/pants, athletic shorts, bike shorts, yoga attire and warm-up suits

Country Club Casual

Collared shirts for men and appropriate dress for women is required. Nice jeans are acceptable (not ripped, torn, tattered, frayed or dirty). Proper Golf and Tennis attire is acceptable.

Not Acceptable

Cotton t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweatpants, tank tops, tube tops, midriff baring attire, short shorts, cut-offs and inappropriate athletic attire including yoga pants, short athletic shorts, bike shorts, and warm-up suits unless inside the Fitness Rooms, Tennis Courts or Pool areas. For sports attire that violates the Club dress code, appropriate outerwear is required as a cover up.

<u>Hats</u>

Should be worn with the bill facing forward (not backwards) on the Golf Course, at the Grille and on the Patios. Hats are not acceptable inside the Clubhouse for gentlemen. Dressy Hats, religious or health related head coverings will be allowed for appropriate occasions.

Shoes

Golf shoes, dress and casual shoes such as loafers and sandals are suggested footwear on Club grounds.

Children

We love that Eagle Brook's littlest members get to enjoy the club. Please keep in mind all children 16 and under must be supervised by an adult and must be 18 to enter the locker room unaccompanied.

Children's Dress Policy

For children under 12, we ask parents to encourage appropriate dress while at the Club. Once children turn 12 years old, they are expected to comply with the adult dress code policies.

As you may know, we are facing ever increasing operating costs. With that in mind, we will be implementing a 2.5% surcharge to monthly statements for members who autopay by debit or credit card, to offset the fees charged to us by our credit card processing company.

If you would like to avoid this charge you may choose to set up your monthly billing utilizing ACH or paying by check, before autopay is run for the month. To change to an ACH withdrawal, you can update via the club website or by contacting our club accountant and provide them with your bank name, checking account number, and routing number. Please refer to your member statement regarding the day of the month autopay will draft your payment. Any updates to payment preference must be made before autopay is run to avoid the surcharge for that month.
